

Patriotic Sensory Bin

- Get a bucket, bowl or container of some sort. Fill the bucket with rice.
- Put items that are red, white and blue in the container with the rice.
 They can be any items!
- Put in spoons, cups, or any smaller containers you have in the house
- Allow your child to explore in the patriotic sensory box! When your child finds an item, label what color it is and what the object is. Ex: "Oh! You found a red ball!

Questions to ask

Do you see anything blue? Point to it!

Do you see anything red? Point to it!

Do you see anything white? Point to it!

Can you find any people?

What are the people doing?

You can ask these questions and answer them aloud to help your student practice vocabulary and identifying.

Fireworks

Let's make fireworks! You will need

- Toilet Roll
- Scissors
- Paint
- Paper
- Plate

Make Cuts into your paper roll. Put paint on the plate. Dip your toilet roll with cuts into the paint. Then press onto your paper.




Was Daniel Tiger afraid of fireworks? What can we do when we are afraid?

Star Craft

Now let's make a ripped paper star! You will need:

- Paper to Cut a Star
- Scissors
- Paper to rip
- Glue (if you want)

Cut out a star shape. Have your child rip pieces of paper up. Ripping is a great way to increase fine motor strength. After you have ripped pieces of paper, have your student place them (or glue them) inside the star.

Water Painting



PAINTING WITH WATER & cotton balls

While you're outside, let's do some painting at our picnic! All you will need are 3 items!


- Water
- Cup (to put water in)
- Cotton balls
- Paper

Water painting! Have your child paint with water on a dry piece of colored paper. They can dip the cotton balls in water and use that to "paint" on the page!

If you have red or blue that would be great! Otherwise use what you have. Talk with your student about what they are seeing and feeling. Describe how the paper feels when it is wet (soft, gummy, sticky) and how it feels when it is not wet (dry, rough). See if you can make stars with your water painting!
