

CHILDREN SHOULD STAY AT HOME WHEN.....

- The child has a **fever of 100 degrees and above**. The child can return to school once they have been fever free for 24 hours without the use of Tylenol or Motrin.
- A **skin rash of an unknown cause** is present. A doctor's note is needed indicating the rash is not contagious.
- **Vomiting** is active.
- **Diarrhea** is active.
- A **hacking, persistent cough** is present.
- There is **yellow or green drainage from the nose or mouth**.
- They are having **breathing difficulties**.

******If a student presents in school with any of the above symptoms, the student will be assessed by the nurse, his or her parents will be notified and instructed to pick up their child and the student will be excluded. The student may be referred for evaluation by their physician and upon return to school should submit the completed physician's report. The student can return to school once the symptoms have been resolved for 24 hours and or a return to school statement has been received from the student's doctor.******

******If the student is diagnosed with a contagious condition, please inform the School Nurse as soon as possible and provide written documentation.******
